Window Sticker

Instructions

Create personalised window stickers from images or company logos using your inkjet printer. Use it for promotions, advertising, machinery labels, or window displays, this product can have many applications, and will not leave a residue when it's time to be removed.

Made from PET plastic, the film will produce high quality images using any ink or pigment. The strong adhesive backing will cling to virtually any surface

How to Use

1. Edit your photo or image on your computer to fit on A4 size.
2. Make sure that you reverse/mirror the image for printing as the film is not ideal for exterior use as it is not waterproof so it should be placed on the inside of the window facing out.
3. Set the printer's paper mode as "Inkjet Clear Film" and "High Photo Quality".
4. Check that you have selected the matte finish side of the film for printing. The backing film has a glossy finish. If you print on the wrong side, the ink will not take to the film and will appear watery and blurred. Simply wipe off and start again if this occurs.
5. If not using the whole sheet, cut out your images out.
6. Remove the backing film and stick onto the desired surface.
